 Pedal off the beaten path in one of Tennessee's largest counties, named for Revolutionary War hero General "Mad Anthony" Wayne.

We start at Waynesboro City Park and explore Wayne County along routes developed by experienced cyclists that follow a variety of rural, hilly, shady and sunny routes.

You will ramble through wooded hills with spring-fed creeks and lush valleys that are home to cattle, deer and wild turkey. All routes will travel along the Antebellum Columbia-Clifton Turnpike, established prior to the Civil War and traveled extensively throughout the War.

After resting at the Tennessee Riverfront in the historic river city of Clifton, the 35 and 60 miles routes return to Waynesboro via the turnpike. The 75 and 100 mi routes continue you through the Beech Creek community on toward the popular Buffalo River. Check out the canoeing action at CrazyHorse Recreational Park. Take in portions of Lewis and Perry Counties.

The 60 and regular century routes carry you to the Wayne County Welcome Center in Collinwood where our staff of volunteers will make you feel right at home! Our regular century is challenging with about 4000 ft of climbing

 **This is a tour and not a race.** Plan to ride at a rate appropriate to your training and road conditions. There are challenging hills on the longer routes, so please be sure you are adequately trained and that your bike, including tires and brakes, is in good working order.

All Riders must wear helmets.
